MSMEs embody the overwhelming majority of firms and are the economic backbone of Southern and Eastern Mediterranean countries (SEMCs).



# Main reasons for MSME underperformance

Political instability and institutional uncertainty.



Sterile business environment.



Restricted access to finance.



 Poor
enterpreneurial culture, ability and ambition.



 Widespread
informality with low quality jobs and no social security



Very limited regional MSMEs engagement in exports, internationalisation and global value chain
